ENVELOPE SYSTEM DIRECTIONS

- 1. First, enter each budget item you want to use cash envelopes for in the "item" column, along with the amount for each in the *Amount* column.
- 2. Next, enter the denominations you need for each item in the 100's, 50's, 20's, 10's, 5's, and 1's columns.
- 3. Add up all the items in the **Amount** column, and enter the **Total** at the bottom.
- 4. Next, add up the 100's, 50's, 20's, 10's, 5's, and 1's columns and enter the *Total* for each column at the bottom.
- 5. Make sure the *Total* of the 100's, 50's, 20's, 10's, 5's, and 1's columns equals the total of the *Amounts* column.
- 6. Write down the amount you need for each denomination, along with the grand total. Take it to the bank and make a withdrawal. The teller should give you the denominations you asked for on your note.
- 7. Distribute the cash to the proper envelopes in the proper amounts listed on your worksheet.
- 8. Spend money from the envelopes throughout the month. Make sure you pace yourself so you don't spend it too quickly.
- 9. Start over next month, and do it again every month-forever!

The goal of the envelope system is to never spend more than you make. When combined with a zero-based budget every month, you'll know exactly where your money goes every month without question.

This will allow you to start eliminating credit cards from your life and adopt a lifestyle that most people can't imagine. People might think you're a little weird when you stick to a spending plan and use cash envelopes.

But hey, that's a good thing! Most people are broke, even if they don't look or act like it. WEIRD IS GOOD!
